There were two Secondary School county champions in the Inter boys 3000 metres and junior girls 1500 metres. The club had three representatives for Leicestershire at the Inter Counties Athletics meeting which Leicestershire won for only the second time in twenty five years.

Thirteen athletics club records had been broken during the season and early in May the club gained their first county champion at the Leicestershire Track and Field Championships. Amy Shaw won the under 13 girls javelin only to be followed later in the day by Matthew Garrett winning the under 11 boys Quad Kids. In acknowledgement of this achievement these two were presented with the 2011 Athletics Awards.
