Amber Stevens took an early lead amongst the girls in the Year 1-6 (Under 11s) race and was comfortably the first girl home finishing the course in a time of 6.34. Amber was followed in for the Robins by Isobel Armstrong finishing in 7.04, Bella Kemp 7.07, Kate Riley 7.49 and Jasmine Stevens 7.57. Leah Smith and Natasha Kirk crossed the line together in 8.01 after a sprint for the finish. Holy Powell and Mia Rawlings also fought to the end crossing the line in 8.12 and 8.13 respectively. These were followed by Bethan Douglas in 8.48, and Amy Clark and Rosie Tipper crossing the line at 8.50. Rhiannon Woolerton finished in 9.17 followed by one of our youngest competitors Hannah Edwards who completed the course in 10.16.

The Robins boys in the junior race clocked some great times with Henry Jameson finishing in 6.35, Reece Redfern sprinting in 6.40 and Matt Garrat completing in 7 minutes dead.
